

CROCHETED POT/DISH SCRUBBER INSTRUCTIONS

- You will need 3 inch wide netting and a size K crochet hook
- make a loop



- chain 4
- close the ring with another chain stitch
- chain 2
- double crochet (DC) 15 through the ring (and the “tail end” of the netting) to create the first row
- on second part of the last DC, grab the top of the “chain 2”
- chain 2
- DC two through each “hole” to create the second row
- on the second part of the last DC, grab the top of the second “chain 2”

- chain 1
- single crochet (SC) once in the next two holes
- SC twice in the next hole
- repeat the last two steps until the third row is complete
- cut off netting at 6"-8" and pull the tail end through the last SC
- using a darning needle, weave the tail end of the netting to secure it
- cut off extra tail ends
